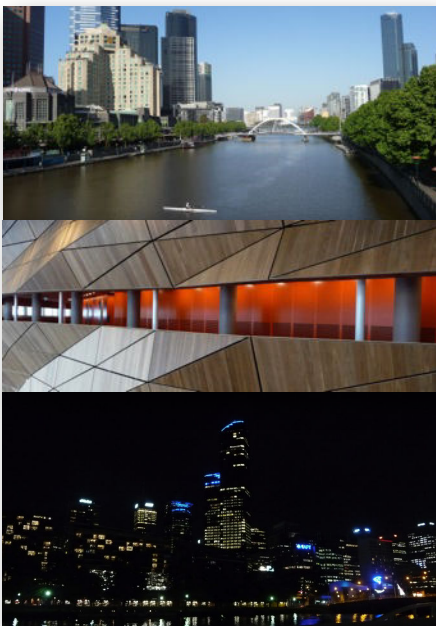
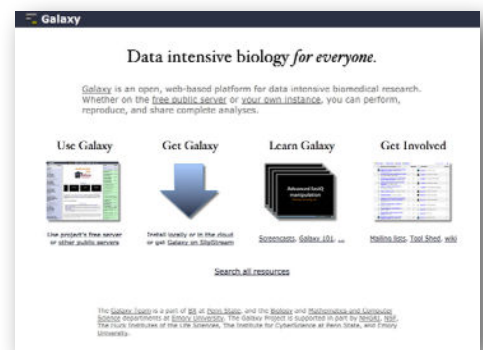




24-25 March Melbourne

The *Galaxy Australasia Workshop (GAW 2014)* is a great opportunity to participate in two full days of presentations, discussions, poster sessions, keynotes and lightning talks, all about ways of using Galaxy for high-throughput biology, imaging and other scientific applications. The workshop will also include Training Sessions taught by Galaxy developers and master users.



GAW 2014 will run 24 and 25th March, immediately before *Computational and Simulation Sciences and eResearch* in Melbourne. Day 1 will be in Clayton (next to the Australian Synchrotron) and Day 2 downtown at the Melbourne Convention Centre.

Galaxy is an open, web-based platform for data intensive biomedical research that enables bioinformaticians and bench scientists alike to create, run, refine, and share analyses.

Registration is free. However, space is limited so early registration is strongly encouraged.
